- 3 SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF UNWROUGHT TITANIUM FOR
- 4 GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES.
- 5 (a) In General.—Section 503(b)(1) of the Trade
- 6 Act of 1974, (19 U.S.C. 2463) is amended—
- 7 (1) by redesignating subparagraph (G) as sub-
- 8 paragraph (H); and

I	(2) by inserting after subparagraph (F) the fol-
2	lowing new subparagraph:
3	"(G) Unwrought titanium products de-
4	scribed in subheading 8108.10.50 of the Har-
5	monized Tariff Schedules of the United States
6	as in effect on July 1, 1998.".
7	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
8	this section shall apply with respect to articles entered,
9	or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, after the
0	date of this Act.
