A BILL

To amend chapter 63 of title 5, United States Code, to increase the amount of leave time available to a Federal employee in any year in connection with serving as an organ donor, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED LEAVE TIME TO SERVE AS AN**
4 **ORGAN DONOR.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (b) of the first section
6 6327 of title 5, United States Code (relating to absence
7 in connection with serving as a bone-marrow or organ
8 donor) is amended to read as follows:

1 “(b) In any calendar year an employee may use—

2 “(1) not to exceed 7 days of leave under this

3 section to serve as a bone-marrow donor; and

4 “(2) not to exceed 30 days of leave under this

5 section to serve as an organ donor.”.

6 (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—(1) The second sec-

7 tion 6327 of title 5, United States Code (relating to ab-

8 sence in connection with funerals of fellow Federal law en-

9 forcement officers) is redesignated as section 6328.

10 (2) The table of sections for chapter 63 of title 5,

11 United States Code, is amended by adding after the item

12 relating to section 6327 the following:

“6328. Absence in connection with funerals of fellow Federal law enforcement officers.”.
