2	(3) as paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively;
3	(B) by striking "Whoever" and all that fol-
4	lows through "otherwise than" and inserting
5	"Whoever, otherwise than";
6	(C) by redesignating subparagraphs (A)
7	and (B) as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively,
8	and indenting appropriately; and
9	(D) in paragraph (1), as so designated, by
10	striking "or" at the end; and
11	(2) in subsection (d), by striking "paragraphs
12	(2) and (3)" and inserting "paragraphs (3) and
13	(4)".
