## A BILL

To provide a limited waiver for certain foreign students of the requirement to reimburse local educational agencies for the costs of the students' education.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LIMITED WAIVER OF REIMBURSEMENT RE-
- 4 QUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN FOREIGN STU-
- 5 DENTS.
- 6 Section 214(l)(1) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 7 Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(l)(1)), as added by section 625(a)(1)
- 8 of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Respon-
- 9 sibility Act of 1996 (110 Stat. 3009–699), is amended—

(1) in subparagraph (B), by redesignating 1 2 clauses (i) and (ii) as subclauses (I) and (II), respec-3 tively; 4 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) and 5 (B) as clauses (i) and (ii), respectively; "(l)(1)" 6 (3)by striking and inserting ((1)(1)(A)); and 7 8 (4) by adding at the end the following new sub-9 paragraph: "(B) The Attorney General shall waive the applica-10 11 tion of subparagraph (A) for an alien seeking to pursue 12 a course of study in a school served by a local educational agency (as defined in section 14101 of the Elementary and 13 14 Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 8801) if the 15 agency determines and certifies to the Attorney General that such waiver will promote the educational interest of 16 17 the agency and will not impose an undue financial burden 18 on the agency.".
