- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Senate Day Care Cen-

- 6 SEC. 2. RECYCLING FUNDING FOR THE SENATE DAY CARE
- 7 CENTER.
- 8 (a) In General.—The Architect of the Capitol shall
- 9 receive all funds collected through Senate recycling or
- 10 waste prevention programs and deposit those amounts in

- 1 an account in the Treasury which shall be available for
- 2 payment of the activities and expenses of the Senate Em-
- 3 ployees Child Care Center.
- 4 (b) Subject to Appropriations.—Amounts depos-
- 5 ited in the account referred to in subsection (a) shall be
- 6 available to the extent provided in appropriations Acts.
