1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF LIEUTENANT HENRY O. FLIP-**
2 **PER STATION.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at Tall Timbers Village Square,
5 United States Highway 19 South, in Thomasville, Geor-
6 gia, shall be known and designated as the “Lieutenant
7 Henry O. Flipper Station”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility of the United States Postal Service
11 referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a ref-
12 erence to the “Lieutenant Henry O. Flipper Station”.
