- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

 SECTION 1. TEMPORARY PROHIBITION ON IMPLEMENTA
 TION OF NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING

 WATER REGULATIONS FOR COPPER IN NEBRASKA.

 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-
- 8 ministrator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall

- 1 not implement the national primary drinking water regula-
- 2 tions for copper in drinking water promulgated under the
- 3 Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. 300f et seq.) until
- 4 6 months after the 2 studies conducted by the Centers
- 5 for Disease Control and Prevention in the State of Ne-
- 6 braska and the State of Delaware are completed, pub-
- 7 lished in a peer-reviewed journal, and reviewed by the Ad-
- 8 ministrator and the State of Nebraska.
