1	SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY
2	HOLDERS FROM STRICT LIABILITY FOR RE-
3	COVERY OF FIRE SUPPRESSION COSTS.
4	Section 504(h) of the Federal Land Policy and Man-
5	agement Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1764(h)) is amended by
6	adding at the end the following:
7	"(3) Fire suppression costs.—In the regula-
8	tions required under this subsection, the Secretary
9	concerned may not impose liability without fault
10	against any holder of a right-of-way granted, issued,
11	or renewed under section 501(a)(4) to recover fire
12	suppression costs incurred by the United States with
13	respect to right-of-way.".
