- 5 (a) In General.—
- 6 (1) AGREEMENT.—It is the sense of Congress
- 7 that—

- 1 (A) consistent with the objectives of sec-2 tion 2(b)(1)(A) of the Export-Import Bank Act 3 of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635(b)(1)(A)), the Board of 4 Directors of the Export-Import Bank shall seek 5 to reach an international agreement with the 6 export financing agencies of all the G-7 coun-7 tries regarding the environmental policies and 8 procedures to be used in financing projects; and
 - (B) before such agreement is reached, the Board of Directors shall, on an annual basis, report to the appropriate committees of Congress regarding the Board's actions in obtaining the agreement.
 - (2) Report.—The report required by paragraph (1)(B) shall include a summary of projects financed by other G-7 projects that do not meet the Bank's environmental policies and procedures.
- 18 (b) Definitions of G-7.—For purposes of this sec19 tion, the term "G-7" means the group consisting of
 20 France, Germany, Japan, the United Kingdom, the
 21 United States, Canada, and Italy, established in Septem22 ber 1985, to facilitate economic cooperation among the
