A BILL

To provide that no Federal income tax shall be imposed on amounts received by Holocaust victims.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. NO TAX ON AMOUNTS RECEIVED BY HOLO-
- 4 CAUST VICTIMS.
- 5 (a) In General.—For purposes of the Internal Rev-
- 6 enue Code of 1986, gross income shall not include any
- 7 amount received by an individual from any person as a
- 8 result of a settlement or adjudication in the individual's
- 9 favor arising out of any moral or legal injustice experi-
- 10 enced by the individual as a Holocaust victim, including

- 1 any amount received from the Swiss Humanitarian Fund
- 2 established by the Government of Switzerland.
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—This section shall apply to
- 4 amounts received in taxable years beginning before, on,
- 5 or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
