A BILL

To provide for certain inspections with respect to small farms.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SMALL FARM EXEMPTION.
- 4 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 5 sion of law, with respect to a person who is engaged in
- 6 a farming operation that does not maintain a temporary
- 7 labor camp and that employs 10 or fewer employees, the
- 8 Secretary of Labor may, under the Occupational Safety
- 9 and Health Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 651 et seq.) conduct
- 10 an inspection or investigation in response to an employee

- 1 death and to issue a report concerning the causes of the
- 2 accident.
- 3 (b) Use of Funds.—The Occupational Safety and
- 4 Health Administration is authorized to expend funds to
- 5 conduct an inspection or investigation under subsection
- 6 (a), and shall complete a report concerning such inspection
- 7 or investigation not later than 90 days after receipt of no-
- 8 tice of the employee death involved.
