## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Commerce to ensure that at least an equivalent level of service will be supplied to the public and affected agencies before closing National Weather Service field stations.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- That section 706(e) of the Weather Service Mod-
- 4 ernization Act (15 U.S.C. 313 note) is amended—
- 5 (1) by striking "or" at the end of paragraph
- 6 (1);
- 7 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
- 8 graph (2) and inserting "; or"; and

(3) by adding at the end thereof the following:
"(3) which is located in, or serves, an area
identified as an area of geographic concern in chap-
ter 4 of the report entitled 'Assessment of NEXRAD
Coverage and Associated Weather Services' pub-
lished in June, 1995, by the National Research
Council, unless, prior to closing or relocating the
field office, the Secretary—

"(A) evaluates, as part of the certification process, the effect of that closing or relocation on all weather information and services provided to users served by that field office (including State agencies, civil defense officials, local public safety officials, farmers, and other local citizens serviced by that field office); and

"(B) includes in a certification made by the Secretary under subsection (b) a determination that, after the closing or relocation, at least an equivalent level of weather services provided to the users referred to in subparagraph (A) before the closing or relocation will be provided to those users.".
