5 Section 203(j)(3)(B) of the Federal Property and Ad-
6 ministrative Services Act of 1949 (40 U.S.C.
7 484(j)(3)(B)) is amended by inserting after “homeless in-
8 dividuals” the following: “, providers of assistance to fami-
9 lies or individuals with annual income below the poverty
10 line (as defined in section 673 of the Community Services
11 Block Grant Act (42 U.S.C. 9902)),”.
