A BILL

To increase the period of availability of certain emergency relief funds allocated under section 125 of title 23, United States Code, to carry out a project to repair or reconstruct a portion of a Federal-aid primary route in San Mateo, California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Devil’s Slide Tunnel
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERIOD OF AVAILABILITY.**

2 Section 6 of the Act entitled “An Act to apportion
3 certain funds for construction of the National System of
4 Interstate and Defense Highways for fiscal year 1985 and
5 to increase the amount authorized to be expended for
6 emergency relief under title 23, United States Code, and
7 for other purposes”, approved March 9, 1984 (98 Stat.
8 55), is amended—

9 (1) by inserting “(a) IN GENERAL.—” before
10 “A project”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(b) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Notwithstanding
13 any other provision of law, sums that are allocated under
14 section 3 for any project alternative selected under this
15 section before, on, or after the date of enactment of this
16 subsection shall remain available until expended.”.

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
