A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to adjust
the needs analysis to protect more of a student's earnings.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDENT EARNINGS.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the
5 “Better Financial Aid for Working Students Act of
6 1997”.

7 (b) AMENDMENTS.—Section 475(g) of the Higher
8 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087oo(g)) is amend-
9 ed—

1 (1) in paragraph (2)(D), by striking “\$1,750”
2 and inserting “\$3,500”; and

3 (2) in paragraph (5), by striking “at 50 per-
4 cent” and inserting “at—

5 “(A) 35 percent for available income less
6 than or equal to \$1,500; and

7 “(B) 50 percent for available income great-
8 er than \$1,500”.
