15	onment for life or sentenced to death;

17	"(ii) is a machinegun or a destructive
18	device, or is equipped with a firearm si-
19	lencer or firearm muffler, the person shall

22	prisonment of not less than 30 years;

16	TENCES.—Notwithstanding any other provision

19	tion or suspend the sentence of any person
20	convicted of a violation of this subsection;

23	posed on a person under this subsection
24	shall run concurrently with any other term
25	of imprisonment imposed on the person,

1	including any term of imprisonment im-
2	posed for the crime of violence or drug
3	trafficking crime during which the firearm
4	was used, carried, or possessed.
