A BILL

To amend titles XVIII and XIX of the Social Security Act to permit a waiver of the prohibition of offering nurse aide training and competency evaluation programs in certain nursing facilities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING WAIVER OF PROHIBITION OF OF-**
 2 **FERING NURSE AIDE TRAINING AND COM-**
 3 **PETENCY EVALUATION PROGRAMS IN CER-**
 4 **TAIN FACILITIES.**

5 (a) **WAIVER.**—Sections 1819(f)(2) and section
 6 1919(f)(2) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395i–
 7 3(f)(2), 1396r(f)(2)) are each amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (B)(iii), by inserting “sub-
 9 ject to subparagraph (C),” after “(iii)”; and

10 (2) by adding at the end, the following:

11 “(C) **WAIVER AUTHORIZED.**—Clause (iii)
 12 of subparagraph (B) shall not apply to a pro-
 13 gram offered in (but not by) a nursing facility
 14 in a State if the State—

15 “(i) determines that there is no other
 16 such program offered within a reasonable
 17 distance of the facility;

18 “(ii) assures, through an oversight ef-
 19 fort, that an adequate environment exists
 20 for operating the program in the facility;
 21 and

22 “(iii) provides notice of such deter-
 23 mination and assurances to the State long-
 24 term care ombudsman.”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) apply to programs offered on or after the
3 date of enactment of this Act.
