- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "100 Percent Truth-
- 5 in-Sentencing Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF CREDIT TOWARD SERVICE OF
- 7 SENTENCE FOR SATISFACTORY BEHAVIOR.
- 8 Section 3624(b) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 9 amended—

1	(1) by striking "(b)" and all that follows
2	through "Subject to paragraph (2)," and inserting
3	the following:
4	"(b) Credit Toward Service of Sentence for
5	Satisfactory Behavior.—
6	"(1) In general.—
7	"(A) General Rule.—Subject to para-
8	graph (2) and to subparagraph (B) of this
9	paragraph,";
10	(2) by striking the second sentence; and
11	(3) by adding at the end the following:
12	"(B) Crimes of Violence.—A prisoner
13	who is serving a term of imprisonment of more
14	than 1 year for a crime of violence shall not be
15	eligible for credit toward the service of the pris-
16	oner's sentence under subparagraph (A)."; and
