## A BILL

To make a technical correction to title 28, United States Code, relating to jurisdiction for lawsuits against terrorist states.

- 1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3       *That, effective with respect to any cause of action arising,*
- 4       *before, on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act,*
- 5       *section 1605(a)(7)(B)(ii) of title 28, United States Code,*

- 1 is amended by striking “the claimant or victim was not”
- 2 and inserting “neither the claimant nor the victim was”.
