A BILL

For the relief of Benjamin M. Banfro.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 In the administration of the Immigration and Nation-
- 5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Benjamin M. Banfro
- 6 shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admit-
- 7 ted to the United States for permanent residence as of
- 8 the date of the enactment of this Act upon payment of
- 9 the required visa fees.
- 10 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
- 11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ben-
- 12 jamin M. Banfro as provided in this Act, the Secretary

- 1 of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one
- 2 number during the current fiscal year the total number
- 3 of immigrant visas available to natives of the country of
- 4 the alien's birth under subsection (a) of section 203 of
- 5 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153).
