## A BILL

To prohibit further extension or establishment of any national monument in Idaho without full public participation and an express Act of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Idaho Protection Act  
5 of 1997”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ESTAB-**  
2 **LISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**  
3 **IDAHO.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no exten-  
5 sion or establishment of a national monument may be un-  
6 dertaken in Idaho after the date of enactment of this Act  
7 without full public participation and an express Act of  
8 Congress.
