A BILL

To enhance taxpayer value in auctions conducted by the Federal Communications Commission.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Reserve Price Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. RESERVE PRICE.
- 6 In any auction conducted or supervised by the Fed-
- 7 eral Communications Commission (hereinafter the Com-
- 8 mission) for any license, permit or right which has value,
- 9 a reasonable reserve price shall be set by the Commission
- 10 for each unit in the auction. The reserve price shall estab-

- 1 lish a minimum bid for the unit to be auctioned. If no
- 2 bid is received above the reserve price for a unit, the unit
- 3 shall be retained. The Commission shall reassess the re-
- 4 serve price for that unit and place the unit in the next

5 scheduled or next appropriate auction.
