To amend title 32, United States Code, to make available not less than \$200,000,000 each fiscal year for funding of activities under National Guard drug interdiction and counterdrug activities plans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FUNDING OF ACTIVITIES UNDER NATIONAL
- 4 GUARD DRUG INTERDICTION AND
- 5 COUNTERDRUG ACTIVITIES PLANS.
- 6 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-
- 7 ings:

1	(1) The National Guard plays a vital role in
2	supporting the drug interdiction and counterdrug ac-
3	tivities of the United States.

- (2) The amount of funds available to the States for National Guard participation in such activities has fluctuated in recent years.
- 7 (3) It is in the national interests of the United 8 States to provide stable funding for National Guard 9 participation in such activities.
- 10 (b) Funding.—Section 112 of title 32, United States
 11 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:
- "(i) Funding.—Of the amounts available to the De-13 partment of Defense for drug interdiction and counter-14 drug activities in any fiscal year, not less than 15 \$200,000,000 shall be available for the provision of funds 16 under subsection (a).".
