3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY DUTY-FREE TREATMENT FOR IM-**
4 **PORTS OF DIIODOMETHYL-*P*-TOLYLSULFONE.**

5 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
6 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
7 in numerical sequence the following new item:
