A BILL

To amend title III of the Public Health Service Act to include each year of fellowship training in geriatric medicine or geriatric psychiatry as a year of obligated service under the National Health Corps Loan Repayment Program.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Geriatricians Loan
- 5 Forgiveness Act of 1997".

SEC. 2. NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE CORPS LOAN REPAY-2 MENT PROGRAM. 3 (a) In General.—Section 338B(g) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254l–1(g)) is amended by 4 5 adding at the end the following: 6 "(5) Obligated Service.— 7 "(A) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of this 8 section, each year of training in geriatric medi-9 cine or geriatric psychiatry that is required in 10 order to obtain a certificate of added qualifica-11 tion in geriatric medicine or geriatric psychiatry 12 shall be deemed to be a year of obligated serv-13 ice. 14 "(B) Limitations.— "(i) 15 PAYMENTS.—Notwithstanding 16 the first sentence of paragraph (2)(A), for 17 the year of obligated service described in 18 subparagraph (A), the Secretary may pay 19 up to \$20,000 on behalf of the individual 20 for loans described in paragraph (1). 21 "(ii) Individuals.—The number of fellowship years in geriatric medicine or 22 23 geriatric psychiatry that are deemed to be 24 a year of obligated service under this section shall not exceed 400 in any calendar 25

year.".

(b) Effective Date.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall apply to applications submitted to the Secretary of Health and Human Services under section 338B of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254l–1) on or after 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act.

(2) First year of program.—For the period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act and ending on December 31 of the calendar year in which such enactment occurs, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall ratably reduce the maximum number of fellowship years in geriatric medicine or geriatric psychiatry that may be deemed to be a year of obligated service under section 338B(g)(5)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254l–1(g)(5)(B)(ii)) (as added by subsection (a)) to reflect the portion of the year that the amendments made by subsection (a) are in effect.
