Mr. SMITH of Oregon introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To convey certain land to the City of Grants Pass, Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF BLM LAND TO GRANTS PASS,**
4 **OREGON.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—Effective on the date
6 the City of Grants Pass, Oregon tenders to the Secretary
7 of the Interior an indemnification agreement and without
8 monetary compensation, all right, title, and interest of the
9 United States in and to the real property described in sub-
10 section (b) is conveyed, by operation of law, to the City
11 of Grants Pass, Oregon (in this section referred to as the
12 “City”).

1 (b) PROPERTY DESCRIBED.—The real property re-
2 ferred to in subsection (a) is that parcel of land depicted
3 on the map entitled “_____” and dated
4 _____, 1997, consisting of—

5 (1) approximately 200 acres of Bureau of Land
6 Management land on which the City has operated a
7 landfill under lease; and

8 (2) approximately 120 acres of Bureau of Land
9 Management land that area adjacent to the land de-
10 scribed in subparagraph (1).

11 (c) CONSIDERATION.—As consideration for the con-
12 veyance under subsection (a), the Secretary shall require
13 the City to agree to indemnify the Government of the
14 United States for all liability of the Government that
15 arises from the property.
