Mrs. Boxer introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of a parcel of unused agricultural land in Dos Palos, California, to the Dos Palos Ag Boosters for use as a farm school.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, UNUSED AGRICULTURAL
- 4 LAND, DOS PALOS, CALIFORNIA.
- 5 (a) Conveyance.—In accordance with the provisions
- 6 of this section, the Secretary of Agriculture shall convey
- 7 to the Dos Palos Ag Boosters of Dos Palos, California,
- 8 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and
- 9 to a parcel of real property (including improvements there-

- 1 on) held by the Secretary that consists of approximately
- 2 22 acres and is located at 18296 Elgin Avenue, Dos Palos,
- 3 California, to be used as a farm school for the education
- 4 and training of students and beginning farmers regarding
- 5 farming. The conveyance shall be final with no future li-
- 6 ability accruing to the Secretary of Agriculture.
- 7 (b) Consideration.—As consideration for the con-
- 8 veyance under subsection (a), the transferee shall pay to
- 9 the Secretary an amount equal to the fair market value
- 10 of the parcel conveyed under subsection (a).
- 11 (c) ALTERNATIVE TRANSFEREE.—At the request of
- 12 the Dos Palos Ag Boosters, the Secretary may make the
- 13 conveyance under subsection (a) to the Dos Palos School
- 14 District.
- 15 (d) Determination of Fair Market Value and
- 16 Property Description.—The Secretary shall determine
- 17 the fair market value of the parcel to be conveyed under
- 18 subsection (a). The exact acreage and legal description of
- 19 the parcel shall be determined by a survey satisfactory to
- 20 the Secretary. The cost of any such survey shall be borne
- 21 by the transferee.
- (e) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
- 23 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
- 24 tions in connection with the conveyance under this section

- 1 as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
- 2 ests of the United States.
