A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in a water conservation project with the Tumalo Irrigation District, Oregon.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That this Act may be cited as the "Tumalo Irrigation Dis-
- 4 trict Water Conservation Project Authorization Act".
- 5 Sec. 2. At the request of the Tumalo Irrigation Dis-
- 6 trict, Oregon, the Secretary of the Interior may participate
- 7 in the design, planning, and construction of a comprehen-
- 8 sive water conservation project by the district. The Fed-

- 1 eral share of the costs of such project may not exceed 50
- 2 percent.
- 3 Sec. 3. There are authorized to be appropriated to
- 4 the Secretary of the Interior, plus or minus such amounts
- 5 as may be justified by reason of ordinary fluctuations of
- 6 applicable cost indexes, not to exceed \$15,000,000 for the
- 7 Federal share of costs related to the project.
