Mr. SMITH of Oregon (for himself and Mr. WYDEN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in a water conservation project with the Tumalo Irrigation District, Oregon.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That this Act may be cited as the “Tumalo Irrigation Dis-  
4       trict Water Conservation Project Authorization Act”.

5       SEC. 2. At the request of the Tumalo Irrigation Dis-  
6       trict, Oregon, the Secretary of the Interior may participate  
7       in the design, planning, and construction of a comprehen-  
8       sive water conservation project by the district. The Fed-

1 eral share of the costs of such project may not exceed 50  
2 percent.

3 SEC. 3. There are authorized to be appropriated to  
4 the Secretary of the Interior, plus or minus such amounts  
5 as may be justified by reason of ordinary fluctuations of  
6 applicable cost indexes, not to exceed \$15,000,000 for the  
7 Federal share of costs related to the project.
