A BILL

To provide authority for women's business centers to enter into contracts with Federal departments and agencies to provide specific assistance to women and other underserved small business concerns.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. WOMEN'S BUSINESS TRAINING CENTER CON-
- 4 TRACTING AUTHORITY.
- 5 Section 29 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 656)
- 6 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 7 section:

- 1 "(i) Contract Authority.—Upon the approval of2 the Assistant Administrator of the Office of Women's
- 3 Business Ownership, a women's business center may enter
- 4 into a contract with a Federal department or agency to
- 5 provide specific assistance to women and other under-
- 6 served small business concerns. Each approval shall be
- 7 based upon a determination that the contract will provide
- 8 assistance to small business concerns and that perform-
- 9 ance of the contract will not hinder the women's business
- 10 centers in carrying out the terms of the grant received
- 11 by the women's business centers from the Administra-
- 12 tion.".
