## A BILL

To increase funding for child care under the temporary assistance for needy families program.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. INCREASED FUNDING FOR CHILD CARE.
4	(a) In General.—Section 418(a) of the Social Secu-
5	rity Act (42 U.S.C. 618(a)) is amended by striking para-
6	graph (3) and inserting the following:
7	"(3) APPROPRIATION.—For grants under this
8	section, there are appropriated—
9	"(A) \$2,967,000,000 for fiscal year 1997;
0	"(B) \$3,067,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;

"(C) \$3,167,000,000 for fiscal year 1999; 1 "(D) \$3,367,000,000 for fiscal year 2000; 2 "(E) \$3,567,000,000 for fiscal year 2001; 3 4 and "(F) 5 \$3,717,000,000 for fiscal year 2002.". 6 7 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall take effect as if enacted on August 8 9 22, 1996.
