A BILL

To repeal the requirement that the Secretary of the Navy maintain a dairy farm for the Naval Academy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF OPERATIONS AT THE NAVAL
- 4 ACADEMY DAIRY FARM.
- 5 (a) TERMINATION REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the
- 6 Navy shall cease to operate the Naval Academy Dairy
- 7 Farm, Gambrills, Maryland, in a cost-effective manner
- 8 that takes into consideration local needs and interests.
- 9 (b) Repeal of Requirement To Maintain Dairy
- 10 Farm.—Section 810 of the Military Construction Author-

- 1 ization Act, 1968 (Public Law 90–110; 81 Stat. 309) is
- 2 repealed.
- 3 (c) Conforming Amendments.—(1) Section
- 4 6971(b) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—
- 5 (A) by striking out paragraph (5); and
- 6 (B) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-
- 7 graph (5).
- 8 (2) Section 2105(b) of title 5, United States Code,
- 9 is amended by striking out "except an individual employed
- 10 by the Academy dairy,".
- 11 (d) Savings Provision.—Section 6971 of title 10,
- 12 United States Code, and section 2105(b) of title 5, United
- 13 States Code, as such sections were in effect before the
- 14 amendments made by subsection (c), shall continue to
- 15 apply to the Naval Academy Dairy Farm and employees
- 16 of the Naval Academy Dairy Farm, respectively, for as
- 17 long as the Naval Academy Dairy Farm is operated as
- 18 the Naval Academy Dairy Farm.
