Mr. CRAIG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred  
to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Pyonghui Gonion Arrington.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4       In the administration of the Immigration and Nation-  
5       ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Pyonghui Gonion  
6       Arrington shall be held and considered to have been law-  
7       fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-  
8       dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon  
9       payment of the required visa fees.

10       **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11       Upon the granting of permanent residence to  
12       Pyonghui Gonion Arrington as provided in this Act, the

1 Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to re-  
2 duce by one number during the current fiscal year the  
3 total number of immigrant visas available to natives of the  
4 country of the alien's birth under subsection (a) of section  
5 203 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1153).
