## A BILL

To direct a property conveyance in the State of California.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ward Valley Land
- 5 Transfer Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY.
- 7 Effective upon the tendering to the Secretary of the
- 8 Treasury of \$500,100 on behalf of the State of California
- 9 and the tendering to the Chairman of the Nuclear Regu-
- 10 latory Commission of a written commitment by the State
- 11 to carry out environmental monitoring and protection
- 12 measures based on recommendations of the National

- 1 Academy of Sciences subject to Federal oversight by the
- 2 Nuclear Regulatory Commission pursuant to 42 U.S.C.
- 3 2021, as amended, all right, title and interest of the
- 4 United States in the property depicted on a map des-
- 5 ignated USGS 7.5 minute quadrangle, west of Flattop
- 6 Mtn, CA 1984, entitled "Location Map for Ward Valley
- 7 Site", located in San Bernardino Meridian, Township 9
- 8 North, Range 19 East, and improvements thereon, to-
- 9 gether with all necessary easements for utilities and in-
- 10 gress and egress to such property, including, but not lim-
- 11 ited to, the right to improve those easements, are conveyed
- 12 by operation of law to the Department of Health Services
- 13 of the State of California. Upon the request of the State
- 14 of California, the Secretary of the Interior shall provide
- 15 evidence of title transfer.
