3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS.**

4 Section 214(l)(1)(D) of the Immigration and Nation-
5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(l)(1)(D)) (as added by section
6 220 of the Immigration and Nationality Technical Correc-
7 tions Act of 1994 and redesignated as subsection (l) by

1 section 671(a)(3)(A) of the Illegal Immigration Reform
2 and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996) is amended
3 by inserting before the period at the end the following:
4 “, except that, in the case of a request by the Department
5 of Veterans Affairs, the alien shall not be required to prac-
6 tice medicine in a geographic area designated by the Sec-
7 retary”.
