3	SECTION 1. STOLEN FIREARMS.
4	(a) In General.—Section 924 of title 18, United
5	States Code, is amended—
6	(1) in subsection (a)—
7	(A) in paragraph (2), by striking "(i),
8	(j),''; and

(B) by adding at the end the following:

- 1 "(7) Whoever knowingly violates subsection (i) or (j)
- 2 of section 922 shall be fined as provided in this title, im-
- 3 prisoned not more than 15 years, or both.";
- 4 (2) in subsection (i)(1), by striking "10 years"
- 5 and inserting "15 years"; and
- 6 (3) in subsection (1), by striking "10 years" and
- 7 inserting "15 years".
- 8 (b) SENTENCING COMMISSION.—The United States
- 9 Sentencing Commission shall amend the Federal sentenc-
- 10 ing guidelines to reflect the amendments made by sub-
- 11 section (a).
