Mr. SARBANES (for himself, Ms. MIKULSKI, Mr. WARNER, and Mr. AKAKA) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that Federal retirement cost-of-living adjustments should not be delayed.

Whereas over the years, Federal employees and retirees have regularly been forced to bear a disproportionate share in connection with deficit reduction: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that cost-
3 of-living adjustments for Federal retirees should be paid
4 beginning in January of each year, as current law pre-
5 scribes, and should not be delayed, whether as part of a
6 budget agreement or otherwise.
