- 6 Sec. 2. Prior to the convening of the second regular
- 7 session of the One Hundred Fifth Congress on January
- 8 27, 1998, as provided in the first section of this joint reso-
- 9 lution, Congress shall reassemble at noon on the second

- 1 day after its Members are notified in accordance with sec-
- 2 tion 3 of this joint resolution.
- 3 Sec. 3. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 4 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
- 5 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
- 6 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
- 7 and Senate, respectively, to assemble whenever, in their
- 8 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
