A Resolution providing section 302 allocations to the  
Committee on Appropriations.

1       *Resolved*, That for the purposes of section 302(a) of  
2 the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, the estimated allo-  
3 cation of the appropriate levels of budget totals for the  
4 Senate Committee on Appropriations shall be—

5               For non-defense—

6               (1) \$289,547,000,000 in total budget outlays,

7               and

8               (2) \$255,450,000,000 in total new budget au-  
9               thority;

10              for defense—

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1           (1) \$266,635,000,000 in total budget outlays,  
2       and

3           (2) \$271,570,000,000 in total new budget au-  
4       thority;  
5       for violent crime reduction—

6           (1) \$4,953,000,000 in total budget outlays, and  
7           (2) \$5,800,000,000 in total new budget author-  
8       ity;  
9       for mandatory—

10          (1) \$291,731,000,000 in total budget outlays,  
11       and

12          (2) \$299,159,000,000 in total new budget au-  
13       thority;

14 until a concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year  
15 1999 is agreed to by the Senate and the House of Rep-  
16 resentatives pursuant to section 301 of the Congressional  
17 Budget Act of 1974.

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
