- 4 Senate Chamber) be temporarily suspended for the sole
- 5 and specific purpose of permitting an official photograph
- 6 to be taken of the United States Senate in actual session
- 7 on a date and time to be announced by the Majority Lead-
- 8 er after consultation with the Democratic Leader.
- 9 Sec. 2. The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate is au-
- 10 thorized and directed to make the necessary arrangements

- 1 therefor, which arrangements shall provide for a minimum
- 2 of disruption to Senate proceedings.
