To authorize representation by Senate Legal Counsel.

Whereas, Senator Daniel K. Inouye has been named as a defendant in the case of O’Leary v. Fujikawa, et al., Case No. 98–16439, now pending in the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(2) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. 288b(a) and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to represent Members of the Senate in civil actions with respect to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is author-
