CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress with respect to convicted spy Jonathan Pollard.

Whereas in 1987 Jonathan Pollard was convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment for stealing and selling classified data to Israel; and

Whereas President Clinton is considering clemency for Mr. Pollard: Now, therefore, be it

2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that con-
3 victed spy Jonathan Pollard should not be released from
4 prison.
