- Whereas Yugoslav President Slobodan Milosevic has refused to halt the brutal ethnic cleansing of Kosovar Albanians despite significant international mediation;
- Whereas the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) has ordered warships and aircraft to commence the bombardment of Yugoslav military targets in response to this ethnic cleansing; and
- Whereas the United States, as a member nation of NATO, may be called upon to participate in ground forces to

bring about an end to ethnic cleansing in the region: Now, therefore, be it
