JOINT RESOLUTION

Recognizing the sacrifice and dedication of members of the Armed Forces throughout the Nation's history.

1	Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
2	of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	That the Congress—
4	(1) recognizes and commends the sacrifice and
5	dedication of those serving in, and those who have
6	served in, the Nation's Armed Forces;
7	(2) urges all Americans to join in commemorat-
8	ing and honoring those serving in, and those who
9	have served in, the Armed Forces for their sacrifice
10	and dedication; and

(3) calls upon the people of the United States to appreciate and reflect upon the commitment and dedication of those who since the inception of the Nation have served in the Armed Forces and to take other appropriate steps to recognize and encourage awareness of the contributions that members of the Armed Forces have made to the Nation throughout its history and to recognize the need for a strong, well-trained, and well-equipped military to protect future generations of Americans.
