## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States authorizing the Congress to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the United States.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2   *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3   *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein),*

1 **SECTION 1. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.**

2       The following article is proposed as an amendment  
3 to the Constitution of the United States, which shall be  
4 valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitu-  
5 tion when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of  
6 the several States within seven years after the date of its  
7 submission for ratification:

8                               “ARTICLE —

9       “The Congress shall have power to prohibit the phys-  
10 ical desecration of the flag of the United States.”.

Passed the House of Representatives June 24, 1999.
