- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Employee Educational
- 5 Assistance Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. EMPLOYER-PROVIDED EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 127 of the Internal Reve-
- 8 nue Code of 1986 (relating to educational assistance pro-
- 9 grams) is amended by striking subsection (d) and by re-
- 10 designating subsection (e) as subsection (d).

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after

3 May 31, 1999.

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
