## A BILL

To amend the 50 States Commemorative Coin Program Act to extend the program by an additional year for the purpose of including the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands within the scope of the program.

## SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

The Congress finds the following:
(1) The 50 States Commemorative Coin Program Act established a 10 -year program for commemorating each of the 50 States through designs on circulating quarter dollars issued during the effective period of the program.
(2) The District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands are part of the United States and it is important that the youth of the United States, a large number of whom are expected to collect complete sets of the quarter dollars issued during the program, learn about their national history, geography, and heritage through the program.

## SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO COIN PROGRAM.

Paragraph (7) of section 5112(1) of title 31, United States Code, (as enacted by section 3 of the 50 States Commemorative Coin Program Act) is amended to read as follows:
"(7) Commemoration of 5 territories in 11TH YEAR.-
"(A) In general.-Notwithstanding the 4th sentence of subsection (d)(1) and subsection (d)(2), quarter dollar coins issued during the year following the end of the 10 -year
period referred to in paragraph (1) shall have designs on the reverse side selected in accordance with this subsection which are emblematic of the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands.
"(B) APplicability of other para-GRAPHS.-Subject to subparagraph (C), paragraphs (2), (3)(B), (4), (5), and (6) shall apply to quarter dollars issued in accordance with this paragraph in the same manner such paragraphs apply to quarter dollars issued in accordance with paragraph (1).
"(C) Application of terms.-For purposes of subparagraph (B) of this paragraph-
"(i) paragraph (4)(A) shall be applied by substituting the term 'highest-level elected executive officer of the district or territory' for 'Governor of the State'; and "(ii) subparagraphs (A) and (C) of paragraph (4) shall be applied by substituting the term 'district or territory' for 'State'.
"(D) Application in event of admission as a state.-If the District of Columbia,

American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, or the United States Virgin Islands becomes a State before the end of the 10 -year period referred to in paragraph (1), subparagraph (B) shall apply and subparagraph (C) shall not apply with respect to such State.".
