1	SECTION 1. TEMPORARY DUTY SUSPENSION FOR PER-
2	SONAL EFFECTS OF PARTICIPANTS IN CER-
3	TAIN WORLD ATHLETIC EVENTS.
4	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7	new heading:
	"  9902.98.08 Any of the following articles not intended for sale or distribution to the public: personal effects of aliens who are participants in, officials of, or accredited members of delegations to, the 1999 International Special Olympies, the 1999 Women's World Cup Soccer, the 2001 International Special Olympies, the 2002 Salt Lake City Winter Olympies, and the 2002 Winter Paralympie Games, and of persons who are immediate family members of or servants to any of the foregoing persons; equipment and materials imported in connection with the foregoing events by or on behalf of the foregoing persons or the organizing committees of such events; articles to be used in exhibitions depicting the culture of a country participating in any such event; and, if consistent with the foregoing, such other articles as the Secretary of Treasury may allow
8	(b) Taxes and Fees Not To Apply.—The articles
9	described in heading 9902.98.08 of the Harmonized Tariff
10	Schedule of the United States (as added by subsection (a))
11	shall be free of taxes and fees which may be otherwise
12	applicable.
13	(c) No Exemption From Customs Inspections.—
14	The articles described in heading 9902.98.08 of the Har-
15	monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (as added

- 2 or excluded from routine or other inspections as may be
- 3 required by the Customs Service.
- 4 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 7 on or after the 15th day after the date of enactment of
