- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Part E of the Controlled Sub-
- 7 stances Act is amended by adding at the end the following:
- 8 "SEC. 521. FEDERAL CAUSE OF ACTION FOR DRUG DEALER
- 9 LIABILITY.
- 10 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
- 11 (b), any person who manufactures or distributes a con-
- 12 trolled substance in a felony violation of this title or title
- 13 III shall be liable in a civil action to any party harmed,
- 14 directly or indirectly, by the use of that controlled sub-
- 15 stance.
- 16 "(b) Exception.—An individual user of a controlled
- 17 substance may not bring or maintain an action under this
- 18 section unless the individual personally discloses to nar-
