To require the Attorney General to add to schedule III of the Controlled Substances Act, the "Date Rape" drugs ketamine hydrochloride and gamma y-hydroxybutyrate.

CHEMICAL LISTING. 23 The Attorney General shall specify gamma butyrolactone (GBL) as a list I chemical in the Chemical Diver-
- sion and Trafficking Act of 1988 (21 U.S.C. 802).

1 SEC. 6. EDUCATION AND DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION.

- 2 The Attorney General shall establish programs
- 3 throughout the United States and disseminate materials
- 4 to provide young people in high school and college with
- 5 education about the use of controlled substances in the
- 6 furtherance of rape and sexual assault and shall assist law
- 7 enforcement personnel in the prevention of abuse of con-
- 8 trolled substances for such purposes.
